

RELEASE FOR BEST FRIEND ERRAND SERVICE

_____ (“Releasor”) wishes Best Friend Errand Service, LLC, an Ohio limited liability company, and its members and/or employees Sue Packard and Sue Glew (each individually and all collectively referred to hereafter as “Best Friend”) to undertake some errands requiring Best Friend to have and use Releasor’s car.

Best Friend will decline Releasor’s request unless Releasor agrees to release Best Friend from any liability that is incurred or that arises in the course of performing the tasks requested by Releasor and unless Releasor agrees to hold harmless and indemnify Best Friend from any liability or damage that results from the operation of Releasor’s car,

So, Best Friend and Releasor agree to the following arrangement intended to insulate Best Friend from any liability whatsoever arising out of the possession or operation of the Releasor’s car.

Releasor releases Best Friend Errand Service, LLC and/or Sue Packard and/or Sue Glew from all claims or rights of action of any kind arising from the operation of Releasor’s car by Best Friend Errand Service, LLC and/or Sue Packard and/or Sue Glew, including injuries, damage, and losses that may develop but have not yet been developed and those that may occur but have not yet occurred, as well as any that presently exist and are known or unknown or discovered or undiscovered.

Releasor agrees to hold harmless Best Friend Errand Service, LLC and/or Sue Packard and/or Sue Glew from any liabilities, claims, rights of action, or damages or legal claims of any kind arising from the possession or operation of Releasor’s car by Best Friend Errand Service, LLC, and/or Sue Packard and/or Sue Glew, or any other agent or employee of Best Friend Errand Service, LLC.

Releasor agrees to indemnify Best Friend Errand Service, LLC and/or Sue Packard and/or Sue Glew from any losses or damages incurred by Best Friend Errand Service, LLC, Sue Packard, and/or Sue Glew during the bailment and the operation of the automobile that is the subject of this release.

“Car” as that term is used here in refers to any vehicle belonging to or rightfully in the possession of Releasor that is given, lent, entrusted, or otherwise tendered into the possession of Best Friend from Releasor’s possession.

This release binds Releasor, and Releasor’s heirs, successors, assigns, personal representatives, executors, and administrators, and anyone claiming by or through Releasor.

This instrument is to be construed under the laws of the State of Ohio. Exclusive jurisdiction and venue for any disputes or actions under this agreement or arguably related to it is vested in the courts of Butler County, Ohio.

This Release is intended to benefit Best Friend Errand Service, LLC, and Sue Packard personally, and Sue Glew personally.
